Pay particular attention to treatment of the crutch, pizzles and polls. If used in jetting races a reduced period of protection may result. Heavy rain following the application of this product could diminish the period of protection.
		Dipping (Plunge, Shower and Constant Replenishment)	2 L per 1000 L	2 L per 1000 L	1. Dip sheep at onset of fly wave. 2. Thoroughly saturate sheep. When using a shower dip, run top and bottom sprays independently so as to ensure maximum pressure and therefore penetration. 3. The product is a non-stripping dip so there is no need to reinforce during dipping. 4. Dipping sheep heavily infested with grass seeds in not recommended. 5. Heavy rain following the application of this product could diminish the period of protection.
9		Dressing	2 L per 1000 L	_	Clip the wool surrounding the strike, treat the struck area and the surrounding wool with a recommended knockdown product then thoroughly jet the sheep with Vetrazin. This product is a slow killing larvicide and when used on its own, larvae may take 3 to 4 days to die.
